- I. Emphasize the need for universal effectiveness of the norms, principles and values of the United Nations aimed at facing the impact of the multiple dimensions of security and human rights in Latin America in times of so many challenges for humanity;
- II. Assist the plans and efforts of governments, parliaments and institutions in Latin America, allowing for the broadest scope of human security actions and human rights protection protocols, in the arms of Commitment Number 16 of the Sustainable Development Goals - Agenda 2030 of the United Nations that seeks with perseverance fairer, more peaceful, inclusive and in solidarity societies;
- III. Recommend to the United Nations the technical, operational, academic and scientific cooperation, as well as the structure for the implementation of the best architectural practices of human security, in Latin American cities, to overcome the filters of poverty, vulnerability, inequality, risk, prejudice, disease and deprivation, in the environmental coexistence of people in families and community environment;
- IV. Announce the Special Edition of the Report on the Observatory of Violent Deaths in Latin America to be presented at the 14th United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, in Kyoto, Japan, from March 7th to 12th, 2021.
